

1. Layered Navigation Configuration


Once you are finished with installing the extension it is time to proceed to your Magento 2 backend to finalize the Layered Navigation setup.

We suggest running through the Layered Navigation settings and other options available to adjust the Layered Navigation. This will help in better understanding of how the extension functions and what can you expect your stores to look and feel like.

To configure Layered Navigation extension, go to **Stores > Configuration > Ulmod Extensions > Layered Navigation**

Set the Enable Module option to **'Yes'** to enable the extension in frontend or to **'No'** to disable the extension in frontend .

Set the **Enable Multiple Filter** option to **'Yes'** to allows customer to select multiple options on same layered navigation filter or to **'No'** to allows customer to filter by one product attribute before updating the result.
