




# 1. Canonical URL Configuration

Once you are finished with installing the extension it is time to proceed to your Magento 2 backend to finalize the Canonical URL setup.

Before start using the extension, we suggest running through the Canonical URL extension settings and other options available to adjust the settings. This will help in better understanding of how the extension functions and what can you expect your canonical URL to look and feel like.



# 1.2. Canonical URLs Settings

Please, disable the default Magento 2 canonical under the **Configuration -> Catalog -> Catalog -> Search Engine Optimization** section before enable the extension.

### General



**Enable** – set 'Yes' to add canonical meta tag in meta header for any targeted page or 'No' to disable.

Set 'Yes' to add a canonical meta tag in category pagination page (pager).

Choose to add canonical meta tag to the layered navigation pages for filtered page or current category

Canonical meta tag for store url
(cross domain) — specify the main
domain from other domains that
have similar content. The canonical
tag will be added on the main
domain.

Canonical meta tag for custom url (cross domain) — Specify the custom URL for the domain to add the canonical meta tag.



# 1.2. Canonical URLs Settings

Trailing slash for canonical meta tag Crop Trailing slash will be added or cropped to the pages without suffix .html or .htm catalog\_product\_view Exclude canonical meta tag on these cms\_page\_view pages cms index index Please specify the pages to exclude or ignore canonical meta tag. One page per line Example: To exclude canonical meta tag on product pages use : 'catalog\_product\_view' Add rel="next" and rel="prev" to the Nο category page The rel=next/prev tag inform Google, where exactly the 1st and the last pages are, and what page is a next or a previous

one.

'Crop' or 'Add' trailing slash to the canonical URL of any pages. One page per line

Add the pages to exclude or remove the canonical meta tag.


### Example:

To exclude canonical meta tag on product pages use: catalog\_product\_view
To exclude canonical meta tag on CMS
Pages (All) page use: cms\_page\_view
To exclude canonical meta tag on CMS
home page use: cms\_index\_index
To exclude canonical meta tag on category
pages use: catalog\_category\_view

Use the **rel=next/prev** tag to inform Google, about the 1st and the last pages, next or previous page.

### 1.4. Canonical URL Per Product Attribute

Set the Canonical URL per product attribute, for pages filtered by layered navigation.
