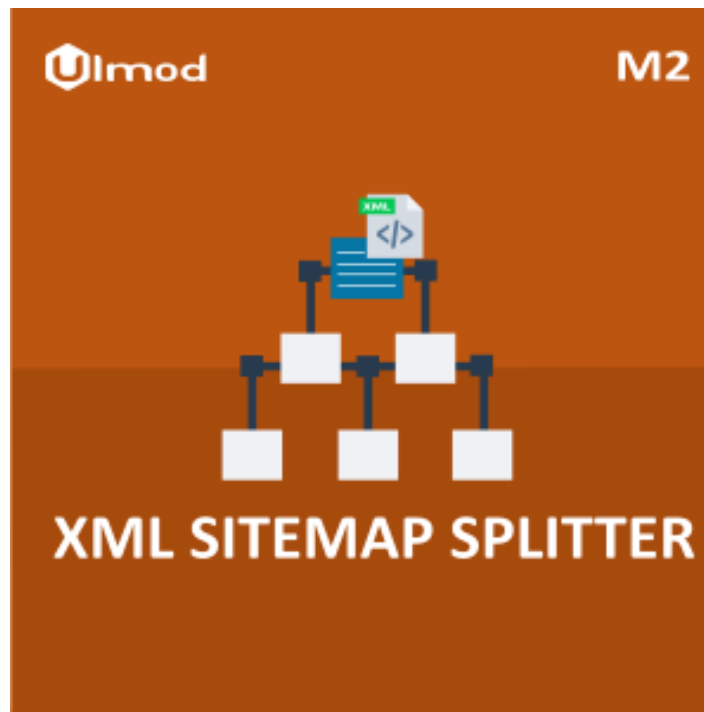

## 1. XML Sitemap Splitter Configuration

Once you are finished with installing the extension it is time to proceed to your Magento 2 backend to finalize the XML Sitemap Splitter setup.

Before start using the extension we suggest running through the XML Sitemap Splitter extension settings and other options available to adjust the settings. This will help in better understanding of how the extension functions and what can you expect your sitemap to look and feel like.

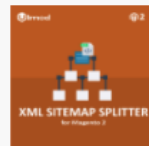

## 1.8. Generation and Search Engine

### Generation

Set the frequency of XML Sitemaps to be generated for your online store. You can choose from 'Daily', 'Weekly' and 'Monthly' options.

Add one or more email address(es) which will receive a notification each time the XML Sitemap is generated/updated.

## 2. XML Sitemap Splitter Management

### Sitemaps

The XML Sitemap Splitter extension enables you to generate and split your XML Sitemap with a number of URLs listed in 'each' XML Sitemap and help search engines to easily understand your website structure while crawling it. Having a properly structured and optimized XML sitemap is critical to making sure your store ranks well in Google and other search engines.

The extension allows you to manage all sitemaps on a clear and flexible admin panel. To view, or edit sitemap, please go to **“Marketing → SEO XML Sitemap Splitter by Ulmod → Sitemap(s)”**. A convenient grid displays all your sitemaps. Discover mass actions to manage your sitemaps faster.

## 2.1.1. Edit Sitemap :

Specify the name of your xml sitemap . This will be the name of your XML Sitemap 'Index' file.

Store View: \* German Store View

Choose the type to generation :

- **'Basic'** generate the default **sitemap** compatible with the major search engine.
- **'Basic with Image'** generate a Sitemap that includes images of your product pages. This format is compatible only with Google
- **'Mobile'** create a separate mobile sitemap and submit it to search engines. This format is compatible only with Google

Specify the location or path of your xml sitemap . This is the location (directory) where your Sitemap file will be generated.


Choose the store view to which you want to generate the XML Sitemap.
